






FIVE- Teams Guideline & Timeline

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


Beauty of Bihać & Una-Sana Canton




Bihać is a city situated in the far north-west of Bosnia and Herzegovina and it is one of the largest and most populated city in this part of B&H. Bihać is also an administrative


center of the Una-Sana Canton with population of 290.000, while around 62.000 people live in Bihać.





